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Narrative

On this date I responded to 14 Market St. on a report of a fire/domestic dispute. Police dispatcher stated that a person was set on fire and the house was burning.

Upon arrival the fire department was on scene putting out the fire. Near the front of 14 Market St. I saw fire department E.M.T'S treating a female victim. I went over to their location and saw that the woman was naked and covered with a bathrobe over her shoulders and I could see that the front of her body was burned, her chest and down to her legs. The female victim was identified as _____ of 14 Market St.

Ms. _____ was in severe pain but was able to tell me that the person who burned her was Howard Stewart. Ms. _____ said that after he set her on fire she believed he fled. I quickly gave this name to the police dispatcher. I then spoke to another female identified as the victims daughter, _____ (6/10/97). _____ told me that her mother's boyfriend did this to them. She stated that lastnight (11/14/09) she told her mother that Howard Stewart had been touching her on her private parts and was scared of him and wanted him to stop. _____ then said that her mother, _____ and Howard Stewart got into an argument. That Howard was yelling "you believe her". _____ said that her mother wanted to wait till Monday to go to the police department to report the incident. _____ said that they argued for a while and that around midnight Howard left the apartment. _____ then said that she went to bed with her mother on the third floor because she felt afraid.

This morning _____ said that she woke up because she felt liquid being poured on her head and when she opened her eyes saw Howard Striking matches and tossing them toward her. _____ said she got up and ran towards the rear stairs to go down and get away from Howard. _____ said that when she ran down the stairs to the second floor she noticed the fire and stopped. She said this was when Howard grabbed her, dragged her back upstairs and threw her back on the bed. Howard poured more liquid on her then ran down the front stairs. _____ said that by then she could see the fire coming up the rear stairs and was about to run down the front stairs when she saw that her baby sister, _____ (8/19/2009) was still asleep on the bed.

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Narrative

██████████ said that she grabbed her sister and ran down to the first floor where she then found her mother and saw that she was naked and that she was burned. ██████████ said that the first floor tenants were on the phone with '911'. ██████████ told them that the second floor was on fire and they left the building.

I then found the first floor tenants across the street, ██████████ (3/23/53) and ██████████ (11/2/54). I spoke to Mrs. ██████████ and she said that she heard loud foot steps upstairs and yelling then someone screaming. A short time later Mrs. ██████████ said someone was banging on her front door, that when she opened the door she saw ██████████ standing there naked and screaming and saw that she was severely burned. Mrs. ██████████ said that her husband had grabbed the phone and dialed '911'. Mr. ██████████ said that he was talking to the operator but that ██████████ took the phone from him and told the operator that she and her baby were burned.

Mr. ██████████ said that ██████████ then came down and said that the second floor was on fire. ██████████ was taken to Bridgeport hospital's burn unit for further medical treatment ██████████ and ██████████ were treated on seen by medical personel and released.

Ofc R. Levy informed me that Howard Stewart was apprehended at Grand Ave. and James St. by Ofc. A. Gamberdella (see his supplement for details). That he was now in his police cruiser at Market St. near Main St. ██████████ was later brought to 1 Union Ave. and interviewed by Det. W. Barret and Det. C. Shaw (see their supplement for details). ██████████ and ██████████ were left in the custody of their maternal grandmother ██████████

Howard Stewart was transported to 1 Union Ave. By Ofc. R. Levy and Ofc. M. Ostigny. Yale child study was notified and Dr. Marans and Ms. Goslin responded to 1 Union Ave. D.C.F. was also notified and I filed a report with Linda Pappalardo. Form 136 will be mailed out. Further supplements will be submitted By Det. W. Barret.

THIS OFFICER AND OFFICER OSTIGNY BEGAN TRANSPORTING MR. STEWART TO 1 UNION AVENUE DETENTION CENTER WHILE ENROUTE TO UNION AVENUE MR. STEWART UTTERED "LATELY WE'VE BEEN ARGUING OVER EVERYTHING, PAYING BILLS ME NOT WORKING".

MR. STEWART THEN ASKED THIS OFFICER "DID YOU SEE HOW BAD MY HOUSE IS BURNED, IS ANYONE HURT." THIS OFFICER TOLD MR. STEWART THAT BOTH OF HIS DAUGHTER APPEARED OK. MR. STEWART STATED "ONLY THE BABY IS MY DAUGHTER, THE OTHER GIRL IS DAUGHTER".

AS I CHECKED ON THE BABY FOR MR. STEWART. THIS OFFICER DID SEE THE MINOR CHILD AND ADVISED MR. STEWART THAT HIS CHILD APPEARED TO BE OK. MR. STEWART ASKED THIS OFFICER TO CONTACT HIS OLDER DAUGHTER AT [REDACTED] AND HAVE HER COME AND PICK UP HIS DAUGHTER. MR. STEWART ASKED THIS OFFICER IF [REDACTED] WAS BURNED BADLY". THIS OFFICER ADVISED HIM THAT I DID NOT SEE HER, WHEN I WENT TO CHECK ON HIS CHILD. MR. STEWART SHOOK HIS HEAD AND UTTERED "THINGS JUST WENT TO FAR YOU KNOW, WE WERE ARGUING ABOUT THINGS AND.....(PUT HIS HEAD DOWN LOOKING AT THE FLOOR)

THIS OFFICER TRANSPORTED MR. STEWART OVER TO MID-BLOCK MARKET STREET AS WE AWAITED INSTRUCTIONS ON WHAT TO DO WITH MR. STEWART. WHILE ENROUTE TO MARKET STREET MR. STEWART ASKED THIS OFFICER IF HIS 3 MONTH OLD DAUGHTER WAS "ALRIGHT". THIS OFFICER REPLIED "WHAT'S WRONG WITH HER". MR. STEWART STATED "DID SHE GET HURT BY THE FIRE". THIS OFFICER REPLIED " I DON'T KNOW I HAVEN'T MADE IT OVER THERE YET". ONCE ON MARKET STREET THIS OFFICER PARKED ON THE SIDEWALK (NORTHSIDE OF THE STREET) NEXT TO A RED BRICK CHURCH. MR. STEWART ASKED THIS OFFICER "CAN YOU CHECK ON MY DAUGHTER AND SEE IF SHE IS ALRIGHT". THIS OFFICER TOLD HIM "YES". THIS OFFICER HAD OFFICER OSTIGNY STAND BY MY MARKED PATROL UNIT AS I CHECKED ON THE BABY FOR MR. STEWART. THIS OFFICER DID SEE THE MINOR CHILD AND ADVISED MR. STEWART THAT HIS CHILD APPEARED TO BE OK. MR. STEWART ASKED THIS OFFICER TO CONTACT HIS OLDER DAUGHTER AT [REDACTED] AND HAVE HER COME AND PICK UP HIS DAUGHTER. MR. 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


I FELT A LARGE COIL IN HIS LEFT JACKET POCKET. AS PULLED THE COIL OUT, I SAW IT WAS A PANTS BELT. HOWEVER, AS I WAS PULLING IT OUT, SOME WOODEN MATCH STICKS FELL OUT OF HIS POCKET. WE FINISHED PATTING THE SUSPECT DOWN; WE PUT HIM IN THE REAR OF OFC. LEVY'S PATROL CAR. OFC. LEVY THEN HANDED ME A FEW MORE MATCH STICKS. WE BROUGHT THE SUSPECT BACK TO THE SCENE. WE WAITED THERE FOR A WHILE UNTIL WE WERE TOLD TO BRING THE SUPSECT, NOW IDENTIFIED AS HOWARD STEWART, TO UNION AVE DETENTION. I FOLLOWED OFC. LEVY TO 1 UNION AVE. AFTER WE PUT THE PRISONER IN DETENTION, I WENT TO THE FRONT DESK AND PUT THE MATCH STICKS IN TO THE PROPERTY ROOM. THERE WERE SIX (6) MATCH STICKS.
